<p><b>Duties</b> On completion of your first year 'off-the-job training', at a preferred Apprentice Training provider within the Birmingham catchment area, you will be working in a modern Press Work Production and Toolroom environment alongside an experienced <b>Factory Services Engineer</b>, to help provide a world class maintenance service to the business.</p>	<p>You will learn about all aspects of the Factory Services role and develop your skills to become an integral resource within the Company. You will be required to successfully complete your "on the job" training to NVQ Level 3 along with day release to achieve a minimum of BTEC/ City &amp; Guilds in Maintenance/ Manufacturing Engineering.</p>
<b>Hours:</b>	<p><b>Brandauer:</b> Mon – Thurs: 7.30am – 4.15pm (1/2 hour lunch). Fri: 7.30am – 12.30pm = 38 hours <b>Training Provider = 38 hours</b></p>
